DoT abolishes NOCC charges for all telecom licence holders

With effect from April 1, 2022, the charges imposed by the network operation and control center (“NOCC”) (earlier DoT levied a charge of INR 21 lakh per transponder per annum for 36 megahertz of spectrum on pro-rata basis) for use of space segment for all the telecom license holders of commercial / captive very small aperture terminal (VSAT) services, global mobile personal communication by satellite (GMPCS), national long distance (NLD) and other telecom licensees having unified license or a standalone license are removed by the department of telecommunications (“DoT”).
