

Suvaaankoor's practice area covers diverse aspects of civil and commercial litigation. He handles sector specific civil and commercial litigation, arbitration, constitutional litigation and regularly appears before the Supreme Court of India, various High Courts, National Company Law Tribunals, National Company Law Appellate Tribunal, various civil and consumer courts around the country.

Suvaaankoor has been involved in advising & representing various diverse clients like state-owned engineering and manufacturing companies, multinational IT companies, manufacturer of construction and mining equipment companies, sports federations in India, Banks and Financial Institutions, developer and property owners, Hospitals, singers and their management companies, and comedy entertainment companies.
